

Jobe wins third Match-Play title

Brandt Jobe of Cherry Hills Country Club won five straight holes during the final nine Sunday to cap a 4-and-2 victory over Indian Tree's Rick DeWitt in the Colorado Golf Association Match-Play Championship at Rolling Hills Country Club.

Jobe, the 23-year-old UCLA star who led the Bruins to the national collegiate golf title this spring, became only the fourth player in the 27-year history of the tournament

to win three or more championships. He had won in 1984 and 1985.

Dr. Larry Bromfield's eight match-play titles remains the all-time record number of victories.

After the first 18 of the 36-hole final, DeWitt held a 2-up lead. But Jobe eagled the short par-5 first hole to go one down.

Dave Buddenbaum of City Park Golf Course defeated Mike Mulhern of Valley Country Club 3 and 2 to win the President's Flight.
