

Amateur golfers rout state pros

DENVER — The Colorado Cup amateur golf team beat the state's professional Cup squad for the second straight year with a 17-7 win at Bear Creek Golf Course Saturday.

With the win, the amateurs now have five victories in the series, compared the professional's 13. Twice the amateurs and professionals have tied since the Cup matches were started in 1971.

The amateur's 17-7 winning margin was the second-largest

in cup history.
